Fire Safety Tips

In October, we went on a walking field trip to the Jacksonville Fire Department for fire safety month. Here are some of the tips you can discuss with your family:

- Check all of your smoke alarms to make sure the batteries are working properly. This should be done every six months.
- Make a plan for where to meet if there is a fire inside.
- Know your escape routes within each room of your house.
- Teach your children that firefighters are there to help. The gear and the mask of a firefighter can look scary, but we need to make sure that we go toward the firefighters in an emergency, we cannot hide from them.
- If clothing or a body part catches fire, make sure to: Stop, drop, and roll until the flames are out
- Children should be able to call 9-1-1 in case of an emergency. Talk with your family about what an emergency is and practice saying your address with your child.
