- Here at Eisenhower, most students will show what they know in **reading** on Monday and Tuesday and in **math** on Wednesday and Thursday.

Family members, here's how you can partner with us:

- Remind your young scholar to take her time and do not rush.
- Remind your scholar to read each question and answer choice carefully.
- And tell that outstanding Eagle scholar to try his best--remember, teachers cannot help!
- And as always, when you think you're all done, check your work.

After our first round of benchmarking, we look forward to sharing special diagnostic reports with you, our partnering parents and families.
